

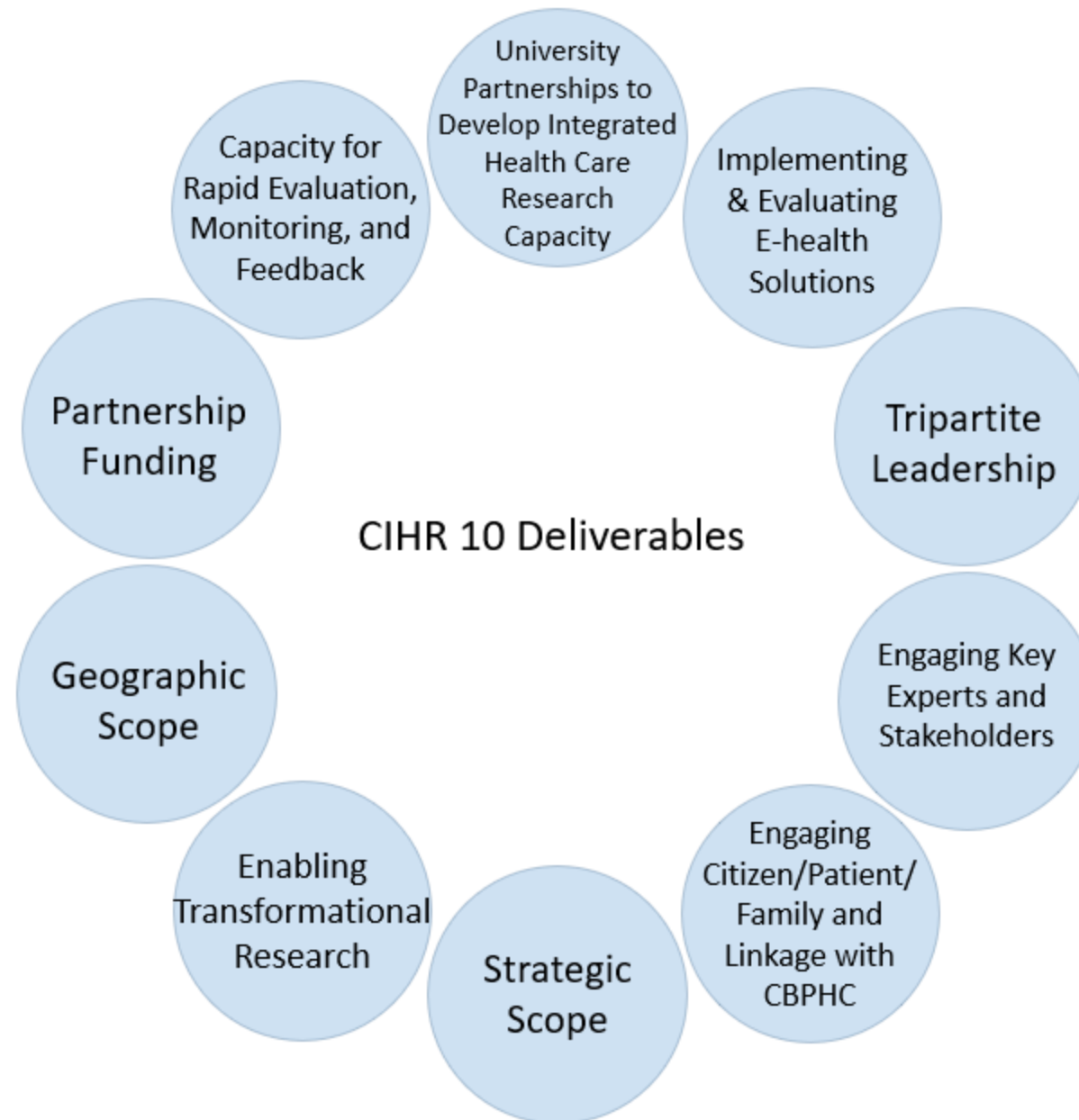
Background
